

ORDINANCE NO. 82-12-20

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly has adopted the policy to grant local units of government all the powers they need for the effective operation of government as to local affairs through Indiana Code 36-1-3-2, et seq.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of New Providence (Borden), Indiana, desires to fix the manner of election of its Board of Trustees.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of New Providence (Borden), Indiana, that:

Section 1. From the effective date of this ordinance, the Town of New Providence (Borden), Indiana, will have a Board of Trustees consisting of three (3) trustees.

Section 2. Each Trustee will run for election as an at large member of the board and the Board hereby states that the town will not be divided into districts for the purpose of conducting elections.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force on the 10 day of JANUARY, 1983.
