

ORDINANCE NO. 83-4-18
ORDINANCE FOR THE SETTING OF EMPLOYEE'S
VACATION

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly has adopted the policy to grant local units of government all the powers they need for the effective operation of government as to local affairs through Indiana Code. 36-1-3-2, et. seq.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of New Providence (Borden) Indiana, desires to fix the length of vacations with pay for its town employee's,

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of New Providence, (Borden) Indiana, that:

Section 1. From the effective date of this ordinance, the Town's unelected employee's shall receive one work week paid vacation equal to the number of hours worked by said employee, after the completion of one (1) year of continual service to the Town of New Providence.

Section 2. From the effective date of this ordinance, the Town's unelected employee's shall receive two work weeks paid vacation, equal to the number of hours worked by said employee, after the completion of two (2) years of continual service to the Town of New Providence.

Section 3. In determining the number of years of continual employment, the time served as of January 1st of each year shall dictate the number of weeks of vacation.

Section 4. Prior Board approval is necessary before a vacation may be taken.

Section 5. In determining the number of hours worked by said employee, said employee's vacation shall be equal to the average number of hours worked by said employee on any given week; and said employee's vacation shall be equal to the employee's work week.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force on the 18th day of April, 1983.
