ORDINANCE NO. 84-5-21

ORDINANCE FOR THE REQUIREMENT OF VAULTS
IN TOWN CEMETERY

WHEREAS the Indiana General Assembly has adopted the policy to grant local units of government all the powers they need for the effective operation of government as to local affairs through Indiana Code 36-1-3-2, et seq.

WHEREAS the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of New Providence (Borden) Indiana, desires to require the use of vaults in all graves in the Borden Cemetery.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Board of Trustees of New Providence, Indiana that:

Section 1. From the effective date of this ordinance, all graves, except those graves and burials paid for by a County or State Welfare Department, must have a vault, made of a non-decomposing material as an outer container, for the purpose of preventing the grave from settling.


Section 2. Furthermore, graves that are to be used for the burial of infants shall not be subjected to the terms of this ordinance.
