

ORDINANCE NO. 86-10-6

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE
THE APPOINTMENT OF A TOWN MARSHALL
AND THE SETTING OF COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly has adopted the policy to grant local units of government all the powers they need for the effective operation of government as to local affairs through Indiana Code 36-1-3-2, et seq.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of New Providence (Borden), Indiana, desires to appoint a Town Marshall and fix his rate of compensation.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Trustees of the Town of New Providence (Borden) Indiana, that:

Section 1: That an emergency exists due to the vacancy of the Town Marshals position, and the fact that the Deputy Marshall has resigned, leaving the Town of New Providence without proper law enforcement.

Section 2: From the effective date of this ordinance, Richard Jackson is hereby appointed Town Marshal of the Town of New Providence (Borden) Indiana, and he is hereby empowered with all powers granted to said position.

Section 3: That the Town Marshal shall receive as his rate of compensation the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per month for his services as Town Marshal.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force on the 6th day of October, 1986.
