

ORDINANCE NO. 86-4-7


AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE
COST OF A CEMETERY LOT

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of New Providence are the owners of the Borden Cemetery and they desire to increase the cost of a cemetery plot in order to provide the Town with more income to properly sustain the cemetery;

IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of New Providence that the cost of a cemetery plot in the Walnut Hill Cemetery shall be increased from \$50.00 to \$100.00 per plot;

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that all money received from the sale of cemetery plots shall be deposited in to a separate savings account which has been set up at Indiana Southern Bank to hold all proceeds from the sale of the cemetery plots, until such time that the Board of Trustees decides in what manner said proceeds shall be used.


