ORDINANCE NO. 93-6-14
AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE CLARK COUNTY
PLANNING ZONING AND BUILDING COMMISSION
TO FULFILL NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Town of New Providence (Borden) Indiana, hereinafter referred to as Town, does not possess the staff to insure compliance with the National Flood Insurance Program;

WHEREAS, the Town desires to appoint the Clark County Planning Zoning and Building Commission to insure compliance with the National Flood Insurance Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Town Council of the Town of New Providence (Borden) Indiana, that:

1. In order to comply with all federal and state floodplain regulation requirements, and in order to stay compliant in the National Flood Insurance Program, the Town hereby appoints Clark County Planning Zoning and Building Commission to review all development in the Town to insure compliance with the National Flood Insurance Program and this Ordinance.

2. The enactment of this Ordinance repeals and replaces other ordinances adopted by the Town to fulfill the requirements of the National Flood Insurance Program.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage by the Town.
