ORDINANCE NO. 94-10-22 CONCERNING THE FLOOD HAZARDS WITHIN THE TOWN OF NEW PROVIDENCE (Borden)

WHEREAS, the Town of New Providence (Borden), in Clark County, Indiana has heretofore designated the Clark County Plan Commission as its planning and zoning authority; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2-1994 (County Ordinance Number) has been adopted concerning building and improvements in flood hazard areas; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance provides that the Clark County Plan Commission has jurisdiction to administer and enforce said ordinance in unincorporated areas of Clark County and in towns and cities which have designated the Clark County Plan Commission as their planning agency; and

WHEREAS, jurisdictions desiring to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program are required to be covered by an ordinance such as Ordinance No. 2-1994; (County Ordinance Number) and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that real estate located within the jurisdiction of the Town of New Providence (Borden) be eligible for insurance available pursuant to the National Flood Insurance Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Town of New Providence (Borden) does hereby indicate its intention to participate (or maintain participation) in the National Flood Insurance Program.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Town of New Providence (Borden) does hereby adopt by reference the provisions of Ordinance No. 2-1994 (County Ordinance Number) and does designate the Clark County Plan Commission as its planning and zoning agency.

Providence (Borden), Indiana maintain a copy of this ordinance, together with Ordinance No. 2-1994. (County Ordinance Number) in the manner town ordinances are kept and available for public inspection.
