

ORDINANCE NO. 94-8-15
ORDINANCE FOR THE
RESERVATION OF PARKING SPACE
IN FRONT OF RESIDENCE

WHEREAS, it is the public policy of the Town of New Providence, Indiana, hereinafter referred to as *Borden*, to provide all citizens with the ability to park adjacent to their residence, where and when possible;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council, that upon a request by a landowner/resident which is adjacent to a Town street where public parking is allowed, a parking space adjacent to said real estate will be provided for the sole use of the resident of said real estate, and this parking space may only be used for cars, vans, pickup trucks one (1) ton or smaller, and motorcycles.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Town Council, that the land owner/resident shall pay the Town a sum equal to \$50.00 the first year, and \$25.00 each year thereafter to maintain the sign; said amount shall be paid by January 15th of each year.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Town Council, that any vehicle which is parked in the reserved parking space other than the land owner/resident will be towed at the expense of the vehicle owner.
