

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-OR-

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A DEPARTMENT OF  
PARKS AND RECREATION

WHEREAS the Town of Borden, Indiana (hereafter "the Town") has recommended that a Department of Parks and Recreation be established in the Town; and;

WHEREAS the Common Council of the Town believes that the establishment of a Department of Parks and Recreation would be beneficial to the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the Town of Borden that a Department of Parks and Recreation is hereby established pursuant to the provisions of Indiana Code 36-10-3;

Section I.

The Park and Recreation Board shall be composed of seven (7) members appointed by the ~~executive~~<sup>PRESIDENT</sup> on the basis of their interest in and knowledge of parks and recreation.

Section II.

Upon establishment of the board, the terms initially appointed shall be:

1. Two members for a term of one year;
2. Two members for a term of two years;
3. Two members for a term of three years;
4. One member for a term of four years.

As a term expires, the President of the Borden Town Council shall make each new appointment for a term of four years. All terms expire on the first Monday in January, but a member shall continue in office until his successor is appointed. If the ~~executive~~<sup>PRESIDENT</sup> does not make an appointment for a new term by the first Monday in April, the incumbent shall appoint a new member for the remainder of the unexpired term.

Section III.

At its first regular meeting in each year, the Board shall elect a president and vice-president. The vice-president shall have authority to act as the president of the board during the absence or disability of the president. The Board may select a secretary from within or without its own membership.
