

ORDINANCE NO. 82-8-30

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPOINTMENT
OF DEPUTY MARSHAL

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly has adopted the policy to grant local units of government all the powers they need for the effective operation of government as to local affairs through Indiana Code 36-1-3-2.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of New Providence (Borden), Indiana, wishes to authorized the Town Marshal, to appoint a Deputy Marshal, and to fix his compensation, term of employment and fix the amount of bond.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Town Board of the Town of New Providence (Borden), Indiana, that:

Section 1. Appointment. From the effective date of this ordinance, the Town Marshall is hereby authorized to appoint one Deputy Marshal, who shall have the authority as stated in Indiana Code 36-5-7 (I.C. 36-5-7-1 - 36-5-7-6) and all other applicable provisions of the Indiana Code.

Section 2. Compensation. The Deputy Marshal, shall receive as his rate of compensation the sum of 100.00 per month for his services as Deputy Marshal.

Section 3. Term. The Deputy Marshal shall serve for a period of 1 years from the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 4. Bond. The bond for the Deputy Marshal shall be set at \$5,000.00 for his term of employment.

Section 5. Termination. That Deputy Marshal may be discharged at any time subject to the applicable provisions of Indiana Code, from his position as Deputy Marshal.

Section 6. Town Marshall. Upon the appointment of the Deputy Marshal, the Town Marshall's rate of compensation shall be decreased to 200.00 per month, which amends Ordiance No. 82-1-482.

Section 7. This ordinance shall have retroactive effect, to and including June 7, 1982, and the Town Beard hereby ratifies and adopts the appointment of Donald Green.
